Parent Pay

To avoid any awkward conversations or letters being sent home please can any outstanding amounts owed on Parent Pay be cleared. We do not like having to send reminder texts or letters home so if payments can be kept up to date it avoids any issues.

For clarity; dinners, breakfast club & after school club should be paid on the day in advance or by the end of the week. Music tuition should be paid within 7 days of the charge being entered on ParentPay and nursery invoices should be paid within 7 days of receipt of the invoice.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club runs every morning from 8:00-8:40am in the dining hall. A healthy breakfast is served and the club costs **£3.50** per session. Children may attend from 8:25 onwards at a cost of **£1.25** but no breakfast will be served at that time. Any children arriving prior to 8:25 will be charged £3.50.

After School Care Club

After School Care Club runs every school day from **3:30-5.30pm** in the dining hall. A snack is provided and the club costs **£3.00** per ½ hour session. Please book in advance with Mrs Johnson and Mrs Stone in the school office. Bookings can be made in advance or on a daily basis – please telephone the office if you need to use either of our wrap round care clubs.
