Start Times in a Morning

Dropping Children off at School

Please do not leave children in the playground alone, as staff are unable to supervise before the start of the school day as they are setting their classrooms up. If for any reason you need to leave before the doors are open the children can attend breakfast club from 8.00am for £3.50 (with breakfast) or from 8.25am for £1.50.

Week commencing **11th May**, the year 6 children will be sitting their KS2 SATs. Please will you be considerate when dropping children at school or taking children from the school during school hours. Can we ask that all children are in school on time.
