Safeguarding Information

Self-harming is when an individual hurts themselves on purpose often to relieve feelings of distress. Self-harm brings a temporary relief for the individual and can sometimes generate a cycle of self-harm. There are no fixed rules or criteria about why individuals self-harm and it is different for everyone. It is important to remember that self-harm is not always obvious.

Talking to someone you trust can help and there are organisations who offer specialist support and help. Your GP can refer your child to CAMHS for an assessment and find a treatment that is right for you. For further assistance - www.nhs.uk

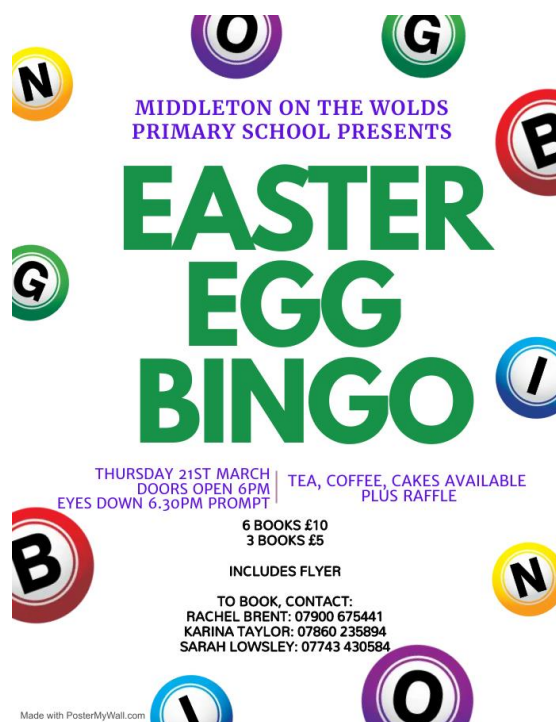
