After School Care Club

After School Care Club runs every school day from **3:30-5:30pm** in the dining hall. A snack is provided and the club costs £2.50 per ½ hour session. Please book in advance with the school office.

Safeguarding Information

East Riding Safeguarding Children Partnership

The East Riding Safeguarding Children Partnership (ERSCP) oversees and co-ordinates all of the work undertaken within the East Riding to keep children safe. It is a partnership between the East Riding of Yorkshire Council, Humberside Police and the NHS Humber and North Yorkshire Integrated Care Board working alongside other relevant agencies. Being a parent / carer or family member means that at times you may have concerns about the welfare of a child, which may indicate signs of abuse. If you think a child may be in danger or at risk, then please contact the Safeguarding and Partnership Hub (SAPH) on 01482 395500 or out of hours on 01482 393939.

If a child is in immediate danger then call the police on 999.

Jewellery

Please note only stud earrings and a watch are allowed in school. During P.E. lessons, the stud earrings should be removed. If this is not possible, please provide sticky tape to cover your child's earrings. No other jewellery should be worn to school. Thank you.

Uniform

All uniform is available to purchase from Drury Sports in Drifffield. Replacement book bags are still available to purchase from school at a cost of £6.50.

Please could we ask that you check all of your child's school uniform over the holidays to make sure that it has their name in. This is particularly helpful when the children are getting changed for P.E. If there is no name in the uniform, then we cannot guarantee that it will be returned to you. Likewise, if your child brings home any uniform with another child's name in, please return it to school. Thank you.
