Attendance

Pupils should be at school by 8:40am each morning.
If your child is absent from school for any reason, please telephone the school on the first day of their absence before 9:00am if possible. The school will telephone you if no contact has been made by 9:30am.

Book Bags

Medical Appointments

Please can we have as much notice as possible for any appointments – we are also asking for evidence for these so we can ensure the correct information is added to the attendance registers for children.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club runs every morning from 8:00-8:40am in the dining hall. A healthy breakfast is served and the club costs £3.00 per session. Children may attend from 8:25 onwards at a cost of £1.00 but no breakfast will be served at that time. Any children arriving prior to 8:25 will be charged £3.00.

After School Care Club

After School Care Club runs every school day from **3:30-5.30pm** in the dining hall. A snack is provided and the club costs £2.50 per ½ hour session. Please book in advance with Mrs Johnson and Mrs Stone in the school office. Bookings can be made in advance or on a daily basis – please telephone the office if you need to use either of our wrap round care clubs.

After School Curriculum Clubs

These will be starting back the week commencing 9th September and will continue until the last week of term. Any changes we will ensure you have plenty of notice. Forrest School is starting this half term for our children in KS1 and will be offered to KS2 children after October half term.

Friday Assemblies

We will be presenting awards each Friday in our celebration assembly to children to recognise their achievement in reading, writing, maths and 'school spirit'. Parents of these children will receive a text each Friday morning so, if possible, you can join us to celebrate this acknowledgement.

Data Collection Sheets

You will shortly receive a data collection sheet for your child.
